<p>Through dramatic play children are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take on roles and responsibilities through creative storytelling</li> <li>• Extend on familiar script</li> <li>• Add to their prior learning</li> <li>• Be creative and let their imaginations to take over</li> <li>• Explore group entry skills, turn taking skills and negotiating</li> <li>• Communicate with each other</li> <li>• Extend on familiar text</li> <li>• Take risks with dramatic performance in a safe and supportive space</li> <li>• Use puppets to explore characters</li> </ul>	<p>As children engage in visual arts they are learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lines – Straight, curvy, diagonal, thick and thin</li> <li>• Shape – 2D, 3D</li> <li>• Texture – Shading, Light, Dark, Smooth, Rough</li> <li>• Colours – Mixing, Primary, Secondary</li> <li>• Material manipulation</li> <li>• To extend on their imaginations</li> <li>• Creative representations</li> </ul>	<p>In music children will explore:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Beat</li> <li>• Notes</li> <li>• Tempo</li> <li>• Rhythm</li> <li>• Piano skills – scales, half tone, full tone, reading notes</li> <li>• Singing pitch</li> <li>• Songs</li> <li>• Introduction to musical instruments</li> </ul>	<p>In our dance space children are learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To extend on their gross motor skills (Loco motor, directionality, levels, skipping, jumping, hopping, balance)</li> <li>• Explore numeracy skills (Counting beats of 8 for choreography)</li> <li>• Hand eye coordination</li> <li>• Different dance styles (Ballet, hip hop, jazz, latin, yoga)</li> <li>• Self confidence</li> <li>• Choreography – Seasonal concerts</li> <li>• To dance as a coordinated team</li> </ul>
